From our President, Cindy Harris:



Winter Health and Wellness

Legislation, Jeff McClain and Denise Deltondo

A full legislative report was distributed at our December meeting. There are two additional bills that may be of interest to you. Thus far they have both had three hearings.

- **HB263 Property Tax Freeze** which would authorize a property tax freeze for certain owner-occupied homes (Isaacsohn D, Hall T)
- **HB274 Property Tax Homestead Exemption** which would authorize an enhanced property tax homestead exemption for certain long-term homeowners (Mathews A, Dell'Aquilla R)
