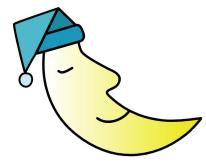
Ordinary Moments

Small events in life can bring on happiness when recalled later, according to research from Harvard Business School. In one study, a group of students noted a recent conversation, the last social event they'd attended, and the last three songs they'd listened to. Revisiting the memories three months later, the subjects rated them as more meaningful and surprising than they had anticipated. The study's lead author recommends journaling and capturing moments instantly in photos and videos to savor them later. (*Psychological Science*, August 29, 2014)



Volunteering Does Good

A recent review of 73 studies involving people 50 and older found that engaging in regular volunteer work helped reduce the risk of depression and increased longevity. Volunteers also reported better overall health. Researchers reported that the "sweet spot" for enjoying the health perks comes when volunteers do about 2 to 3 hours of work a week. What kind of volunteering is best? "[An] opportunity that's socially and mentally stimulating and that keeps you physically active, within your own limitations," says lead researcher Nicole Anderson, Ph. D., a senior scientist at Toronto's Rotman Research Institute. (*Psychological Bulletin*, August 25, 2014) We at TRTA already knew this, didn't we?



Sleep Apnea and Surgery

In a recent study of 20,488 surgery patients by the University of Manitoba, those who were treated for their obstructive sleep apnea before their operation cut their risk for postoperative cardiovascular complications, such as cardiac arrest and shock, by more than 50 percent compared with those whose sleep apnea was undiagnosed. That sleep condition is a breathing disruption that arises when tissue blocks the airway. (*Anesthesiology*, October 2014)

Visiting an Alzheimer's patient

Although someone with Alzheimer's may not remember your last visit, he or she may still have lingering good feelings from your time together, a study by the University of Iowa suggests. These findings "should empower caregivers by showing them that their actions toward patients really do matter." (*Cognitive and Behavioral Neurology*, September 2014)
